Race Committee Member Guidelines

The San Diego Thunderboat Regatta is a world-class motorsports race, showcasing The Warrior Foundation, event sponsors, and powerboat racing. In dealing with the public, boat teams, etc., Race Committee members must remember at all times they are representing each of these organizations, and conduct themselves in a courteous manner. To assist you in your duties, please adhere to these simple guidelines:

A. Committee Members

1. Due to insurance requirements, committee members must be at least 16 years of age.
2. In order to receive member benefits, committee members are expected to work a minimum of 15 hours during the event.

B. Drugs & Alcohol

1. The use or possession of illegal drugs or paraphernalia is prohibited.
2. The use of alcohol is prohibited while on duty or during the times the water is open for racing. After hours consumption of alcoholic beverages of persons 21 years of age and older should not be excessive.

C. Dress

1. Committee members at all times must wear appropriate wristbands.
2. Only committee members are authorized to wear Committee shirts. These should only be worn while actually on duty.
3. Committee members must not wear any item featuring the brand of a competitor of the Event's sponsors.

D. Parking and RV Parking

1. Committee members will receive (1) one parking sticker each to be used in committee parking areas only. However, since parking is scarce, please attempt to limit the number of vehicles coming to the race.
2. A limited number of spots on each venue are available for committee RVs. In order to be considered for one of these spots, members must receive approval from their Committee Chair who will then forward the request to the Board of Governors.

E. Tickets/ Wristbands

1. Each committee member will receive (1) one Committee Wristband to be worn for the duration of the event and (4) four additional superpasses for family members.
2. Any additional wristbands may be purchased through the Race Office, please call (619) 225-9160 to order. Superpasses will be sold at \$20 each and General

Admission will be sold at \$10 each. Limit of 8 passes. The last day to purchase wristbands is August 31st, 2007.

F. Security

1. In addition to other assigned duties, all committee members are expected to remain alert for any persons who do not display proper credentials. If someone is observed without an appropriate wristband, approach them, identify yourself, and ask to see their wristband or credentials. If they have a wristband but are not wearing it, ask them to put it on, and make sure it is secure on their wrist. If an individual does not have credentials notify the security guards immediately.

G. Sponsors

1. Due to the complex nature of sponsorship contracts, dealings with sponsors and their representative should, whenever possible, be directed towards the office staff.
